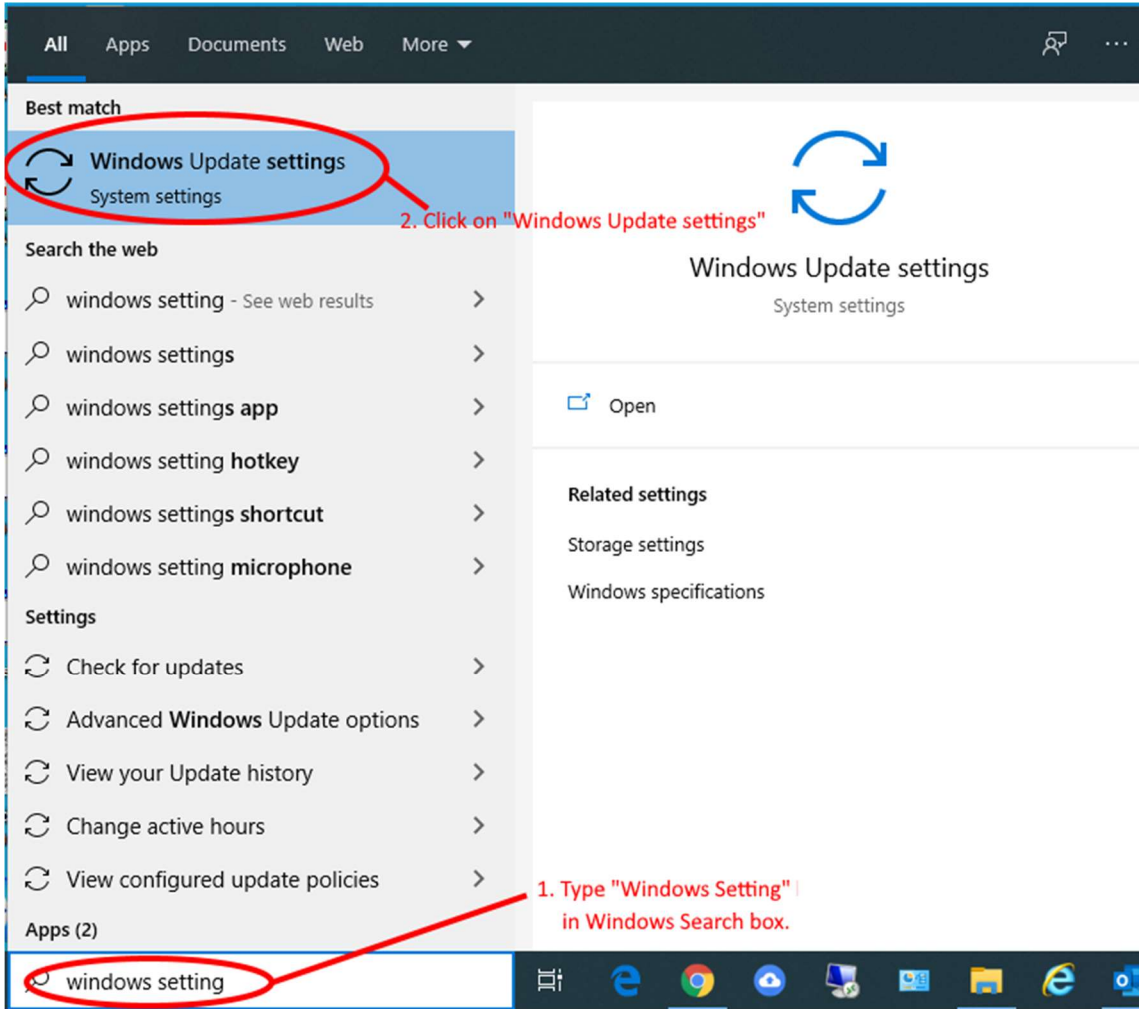

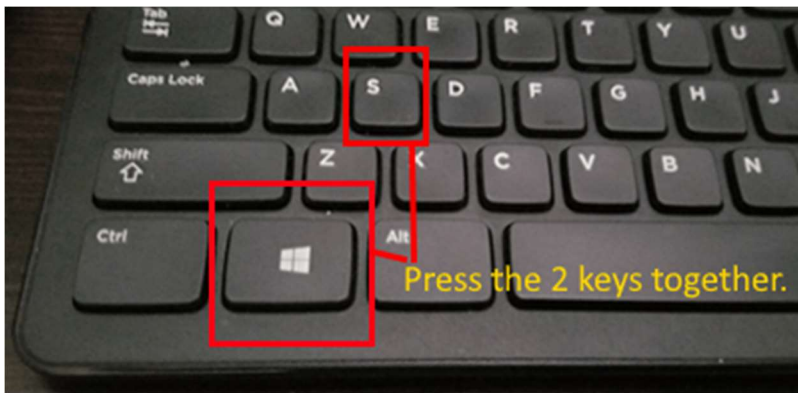


Step 1. Type “Windows Setting” in the **Windows Search box** on the Taskbar at left bottom of Windows.

Step 3. Click on “Pause updates for 7 days”.
